



# **Pastor Kim's Message**

Ever make a mistake?

Yeah, me too. And they haunt me. The voice runs in my head, muttering to myself "how could I have done that? I know better! Dumb, dumb, dumb!" Whether it was something really big, or something that was just plain stupid doesn't really matter.

It is what we do wrong – not what we do right – that we remember the most.

That is a pretty important thing to remember because it means that our mistakes rather than our success affects what we do and how we do it. Being guided by our mistakes creates an attitude of fear that limits what we are willing to try. Fear limits us to patterns of behavior that become "ruts" in which we are stuck, our life a movement down a trough with walls so high that we cannot break free nor can we even stretch high enough to see any other possibilities. Our personalities, hopes, dreams all are limited by the darkness of the rut we are in: we become stuck in a form of our own creation, travelling down the same path until it ends.

Sound horrible? Boring?

Yes. If we look around us we see many that are on that path. And if we step back a bit, and honestly look at our own lives, we may well see that we are in a rut as well (whether we want to admit it or not).

Getting ourselves out of the rut will take some major construction: in fact it will take a re-formation of our lives by being lifted out of the rut and set on solid ground so we can see ourselves with new light.

And that my friends, is exactly what Jesus Christ does.

By His death Jesus hopped down into the depths of the ruts we created and took us to Himself, lifting us out of the path of death and onto the solid ground of life in Christ, where by God we can see the abundant life God created for us. Created, for you.

Because God doesn't focus on all those wrongs that we have done and hold us in that rut. In fact, God takes those things up in His hand and throws them away (Psalm 103). God focuses on one thing: God's love for you (Romans 8:35-39; John 3:16; Isaiah 41:10; 1 John 4:10).

In Jesus Christ God re-formed the world of our lives by giving us life. In Jesus Christ God re-formed the world of our lives by setting out His light so we can see the blessings surrounding us. In Jesus Christ God re-formed the world of our lives by making joy not just a dream but our reality.

#### Sound good?

Then let yourself be lifted out of the rut and your life be re-formed. Come and celebrate the re-formation of life. Come and celebrate the joy that God has created for you.
